To lower the cost of flying for you

To build time

To become part of the teaching community

What Steps to Take to Become a CFI

Can you make Real money?

Probably not in the beginning

Build your base time

Differentiate and niche

What Steps to Take to Become a CFI

Can you make Real money?

Typical Time building CFI wages
- \$25-35/hr.

What Steps to Take to Become a CFI

Can you make Real money?

Typical beginning non time building CFI wages
- \$40-60/hr.

What Steps to Take to Become a CFI

Can you make Real money?

Over 1000 hours and in a Niche
- \$80 - 130/hr.

What Steps to Take to Become a CFI

How much will it cost?

With minimum qualifications and prep
Within a year of commercial checkride
- \$6-11K

- All right seat

Commercial + Instrument or

Sport CFI – Sport Only

Have received ground instruction from an authorized instructor on:

Fundamentals of Instructing

Aeronautical knowledge areas of, Rec, Private, Comm

NO Home-Study Course is Approved

This is not a Self-Study rating

What are the Eligibility Requirements?

Flight training from an authorized instructor

Spin endorsement – Instructional proficiency

There are no Aeronautical Experience Requirements

15 hours of flight instruction – Right seat

Individual ground instruction

Checkride prep ground instruction

What Steps to Take to Become a CFI

A Structured Approach – What does it look like?

How long?

Online – Typically 2 weeks (42 hours)

Immersion class – 7 days (40 hours)

15 hours flight and individual ground – 6 days

What Steps to Take to Become a CFI

A Structured Approach – What does it look like?

How long?

Two weeks on Campus

Checkride during the last days of the second week
