Can you make Real money?

Probably not in the beginning
Build your base time
Differentiate and niche



Can you make Real money?

Typical Time building CFI wages - \$25-35/hr.



Can you make Real money?

Typical beginning non time building CFI wages





Can you make Real money?

Over 1000 hours and in a Niche

- \$80 - 130/hr.

What are the Eligibility Requirements?

Have received ground instruction from an authorized instructor on:

Fundamentals of Instructing

Aeronautical knowledge areas of, Rec, Private, Comm



What are the Eligibility Requirements?

NO Home-Study Course is Approved This is not a Self-Study rating



What are the Eligibility Requirements?

Flight training from an authorized instructor



What are the Eligibility Requirements?

Spin endorsement – Instructional proficiency



What are the Eligibility Requirements?

There are no Aeronautical Experience Requirements

15 hrs. PIC in the Category/Class

A Structured Approach – What does it look like?

15 hours of flight instruction – Right seat Individual ground instruction
Checkride prep ground instruction



A Structured Approach – What does it look like?

How long?

Online – Typically 2 weeks (42 hours)

Immersion class – 7 days (40 hours)

15 hours flight and individual ground – 6 days



A Structured Approach – What does it look like?

How long?

Two weeks on Campus

Checkride during the last days of the second week



A Structured Approach – What does it look like?

What can you do?

Confidently take a person from handshake to Private Pilot Use technology that makes sense for your situation Learn how to present effective lessons

The Getting Started Email

Getting the Online Course – At least two weeks ahead

Choosing a 7-day class – In-person or remote
