Codifies SFAR 100-2 for pilots outside the US - military



Removal of CFI Certificate Expiration Date

After Dec 1, 2024 – Certificates issued without expiration



Removal of CFI Certificate Expiration Date

Recency of experience replaces expiration



Removal of CFI Certificate Expiration Date

Requires IACRA Event – May require ASI or DPE



Removal of CFI Certificate Expiration Date

FIRC – IACRA update by provider, ASI or DPE



Removal of CFI Certificate Expiration Date

Additional Flight Instructor Rating - IACRA



Removal of CFI Certificate Expiration Date

At least 5 applicants – 80% first time pass – IACRA ASI/DPE



Removal of CFI Certificate Expiration Date

121/135 training experience – IACRA – ASI or DPE



Removal of CFI Certificate Expiration Date

Wings - Complete a phase of the wings program Sign off at least 15 flight activities over minimum of 5 pilots IACRA – ASI or DPE



Removal of CFI Certificate Expiration Date

US Armed Forces IP test – IACRA – ASI/DPE



Grace Period

3 calendar month grace period to reinstate



Grace Period

Must reinstate by a FIRC in the 3 calendar months



Grace Period

After 3 cal months – Reinstatement is by checkride only



Grace Period

May not exercise certificate during grace period



Endorsements

No changes to the current method – Date/S/CFI number/Expiration until March 2027



Endorsements

Expiration date or when the recency of experience expires



Training requirements for first time instructor applicants

2 calendar years and 200 hours flight instruction given



Training requirements for first time instructor applicants

5 applicants recommended for a practical test

- 80% first time pass rate – Part 61 or 141



Training requirements for first time instructor applicants

Flight Instructor Enhanced Qualification Training Program – Part 141 or 142 - FIEQTP



Training requirements for first time instructor applicants

No minimum time and no recommendations or pass rates



Training requirements for first time instructor applicants

25 hours ground instruction



Training requirements for first time instructor applicants

10 hours flight instruction



Training requirements for first time instructor applicants

Can use 5 hours AATD



Training requirements for first time instructor applicants

Requires FAA approval – New Appendix K to Part 141



SFAR 100-2 Modification

Active military duty or civilian supporting outside of the US



SFAR 100-2 Modification

6 months after US return to fulfill recency of experience
