8900.2C – Functional – “How To” qualify applicants

How CFIs and Applicants Can Use the Orders

Qualify your applicant with the 8900.2

Specifies what the DPE must validate

Includes required endorsements that must be verified

How CFIs and Applicants Can Use the Orders

Qualify your applicant with the 8900.2

Specifies Medicals/BasicMed and No Medical Test Requirements

How CFIs and Applicants Can Use the Orders

Flight Instructor Practical Test – Reinstatement or ROE tests

No medical or BasicMed is required

Applicant can't be the PIC

How CFIs and Applicants Can Use the Orders

Flight Instructor Practical Test – Reinstatement or ROE tests

61.23(b)(7) – Medical Certificates – No medical for CFIs
Suprise!

How CFIs and Applicants Can Use the Orders

Flight Instructor Practical Test – Reinstatement or ROE tests

61.39(a)(4) – Prerequisites for practical tests – Hold a third-class medical if it is required

How CFIs and Applicants Can Use the Orders

Flight Instructor Practical Test – Reinstatement or ROE tests

It's not – 61.23(b)(7)

How CFIs and Applicants Can Use the Orders

What about – 61.47(b) – Status of the examiner during a practical test?

How CFIs and Applicants Can Use the Orders

Flight Instructor Practical Test – Reinstatement or ROE tests

61.47(b)(1) – Allows the DPE to be the PIC with prior arrangement with the applicant

How CFIs and Applicants Can Use the Orders

Flight Instructor Practical Test – Reinstatement or ROE tests

8900.2C – Section 7-20 – Allows the DPE to be PIC but “Strongly discourages it”

How CFIs and Applicants Can Use the Orders

Flight Instructor Practical Test – Reinstatement or ROE tests

8900.2C – Section 15

b. Medical Certificate. An applicant for a flight instructor certificate is not required to hold a current medical certificate. If the applicant is the PIC, then a current third-class medical certificate is required or, if operating under BasicMed in lieu of possessing a valid third-class medical certificate, a valid U.S. driver's license as well as a current certificate of completion from an authorized BasicMed medical education course.

How CFIs and Applicants Can Use the Orders

Discontinuances and Disapprovals

60 days and 60 calendar days from the **Original Application Date** are the words used in the Order

How CFIs and Applicants Can Use the Orders

Discontinuances and Disapprovals

Related to within 60 (sixty) calendar days

Calendar Days means **days including all holidays**; Calendar Day means the period from one midnight to the following midnight; Days means calendar days unless otherwise specified.

Discontinuances and Disapprovals

FAR 61.43(f)(1) and (2) – uses the words 60 day period
