At least 16 years old to hold a student pilot certificate



§ 61.83 – Eligibility Requirements for Student Pilots

Able to read, speak, write, and understand English



§ 61.83 – Eligibility Requirements for Student Pilots

3<sup>rd</sup> Class Medical/Basic Med unless Pursuing Sport Pilot



§ 61.85 – Student Pilot Application

The CFI must test the student to Level 4 ICAO English



§ 61.85 – Student Pilot Application

AC 60-28B – Link to examples of people speaking at different ICAO levels



§ 61.85 – Student Pilot Application

CFI Submits application via IACRA or paper



§ 61.85 – Student Pilot Application

Student certificate is sent in a few days via email – Plastic card will be mailed

The instructor who solos the student must:

Give a Knowledge test and resolve incorrect answers

The knowledge test must include the following:

Applicable sections of FAR part 61 and part 91

Airport - Airspace/procedures where the solo occur

Flight characteristics and operational limitations for the make and model of aircraft to be flown

The instructor must ensure the student has received and logged flight training and...

...Demonstrated satisfactory proficiency and safety on:

The "15 things" listed in § 61.87(d)(1-15)



§ 61.87(d) – Solo Requirements for Student Pilots

1. Preflight planning and prep, powerplant operation and aircraft systems



§ 61.87(d) – Solo Requirements for Student Pilots

2. Taxiing or surface operations, including runups



§ 61.87(d) – Solo Requirements for Student Pilots

3. Takeoffs/landings, including normal and crosswind

4. Straight and level flight and turns in both directions

5. Climbs and climbing turns

6. Traffic patterns – entry and departures

7. Collision, windshear, wake turbulence avoidance

8. Descents with/without turns using high/low drag

9. Flight at various airspeeds - cruise to slow flight

10. Stalls from various attitudes/power — Recovery at first indication and from a full stall

11. Emergency procedures/equipment malfunctions

12. Ground reference maneuvers

15. Go-arounds

However...

Tasks that the airplane can't do aren't required



§ 61.87(d) – Solo Requirements for Student Pilots

i.e., descents with high/low drag configuration

- Some airplanes don't have flaps



§ 61.87 – Solo Requirements for Student Pilots Solo Checklist:

- 1. Student Pilot Certificate
- 2. 3rd Class Medical/Basic Med or DL if Sport
- 3. Knowledge test (finished/reviewed) A.3
- 4. "15" things Proficient and Safe A.4
- 5. 90-Day Endorsement for Make and Model A.6



§ 61.87 – Solo Requirements for Student Pilots

Endorse the logbook using AC 61-65:

Presolo Knowledge Test – A.3

Presolo Flight Training – A.4

Solo Flight – 1st 90 Calendar Day Period – M/M – A.6



§ 61.87 – Solo Requirements for Student Pilots

The instructor can place limitations on any endorsement



§ 61.87(o) – Solo Requirements for Student Pilots at Night

To authorize solo at night - specific training is required:



§ 61.87(o) – Solo Requirements for Student Pilots

Night training

Navigation training

Night-specific solo endorsement – A.5



§ 61.87(p) – Solo Requirements for Student Pilots

Additional 90-day solo endorsement – A.7:

Must fly with the student to determine safety/ proficiency



§ 61.89 – Student Pilot General Limitations

Student pilots can't:



§ 61.89 – Student Pilot General Limitations

Carry passengers



§ 61.89 – Student Pilot General Limitations

Fly for compensation/hire or in furtherance of a business



§ 61.89 – Student Pilot General Limitations

Fly during the day with flight visibility of less than 3sm



§ 61.89 – Student Pilot General Limitations

Fly at night with flight visibility of less than 5sm



§ 61.89 – Student Pilot General Limitations

Fly without maintaining visual reference to the surface



§ 61.89 – Student Pilot General Limitations

Fly contrary to a limitation from an authorized instructor



§ 61.89 – Student Pilot General Limitations

Instructor's can limit any endorsement – For example: Wind, ceiling, times, duration of the endorsement, etc.



§ 61.93 – Student Pilot Solo XC Requirements

Student solo cross-country requirements:



§ 61.93 – Student Pilot Solo XC Requirements

A Student Pilot Can Fly:

< 25nm of the airport where they train

Can't land at another airport – Until endorsed



§ 61.93 – Student Pilot Solo XC Requirements

For Student Pilots to Land at Other Airports < 25nm:



§ 61.93 – Student Pilot Solo XC Requirements

An instructor must fly with them:

- 1. Over the route in both directions
- 2. Entered/exited the traffic pattern
- 3. Performed takeoffs/landings at the other airport



§ 61.93 – Student Pilot Solo XC Requirements

Endorse per § 61.93(b)(1)


